

## Mt. Olive, Surrey – Drive-through Drop-off Tuesday for Surrey Urban Mission

**Surrey Urban Mission (SUMS) Brown Bag Food Items Collection** – Mount Olive Lutheran Church will be gathering food items on behalf of Surrey Urban Mission.

### WHEN:

**Tuesdays** in June beginning the 2<sup>nd</sup> of June through the 30<sup>th</sup>. (until further notice)

**Between 9:30am and 12:30pm only.**

### HOW IT WORKS:

Volunteers will be available to help you unload your bagged or boxed items into the transport vehicle for same day delivery to Surrey Urban Mission Society

**WHY:** Items are needed to feed the guests at **Surrey Urban Mission (SUMS)**. Several hundred daily sit-down indoor meals cannot currently be served due to Provincial Health Orders regarding physical distancing. **'Brown Bag Meals'** are being assembled and served through a take-out window. Your individual pre-packaged food item donations are most thankfully appreciated.

### WHAT:

Please note: Nothing homemade, spoilable/overripe, outdated or needing refrigeration. Prepackaged items only including:

- 1) **Bundles of take-out containers**, sleeves of Styrofoam cups. Paper lunch bags.
- 2) Juice boxes/bottled water/'Gatorade'/fruit drinks
- 3) Pre-packed soft cheese 'n crackers packs, ready-to-eat tuna in cans, etc.
- 4) Granola bars/Protein bars/Chocolate bars/Bag of nuts/Trail Mix/individual bakery source-wrapped muffin/cupcake/banana bread/non-refrigeration required dessert, etc.
- 5) Prepackaged cookies (not homemade) e.g. Dad's or Dare or... cookies already pre-cello-wrapped in twos or fours, if possible.
- 6) Pieces of fresh (not over-ripe) fruit: banana, apple, plum, orange (no loose berries or grapes, or easily bruised fruit, thanks)
- 7) Small bag of candy/chewy fruit snacks or potato chips (no gum, thanks).

Practical store-bought, prepackaged lunch bag items delivered in a paper/plastic grocery bag/box (SUMS will assemble the meals into bags) to:

**WHO: All of you!** Thank-you for helping feed our gracious neighbours to the north. Many are without homes and are served and cared for by the good people and various programs at SUMS.
